Lighthouse School Leeds is now offering training and outreach support from our school training suite

What is Autism? How does Autism impact young people? How can I change an environment to be more Autism friendly? How is autism identified? What is sensory processing?

Our Autism Awareness workshop will support professionals working with young people with Autism develop knowledge of Autism Spectrum Condition.

During the session you will receive:

- An outline of how autism has come to be defined and diagnosed and terms used. Including facts and myths about autism
- Building an understanding of the common difficulties often faced by people with autism – including delegate problem solving.
- Exploring and being able to assess environments and the challenges that could create for people on the autism spectrum – including delegate problem solving.
- Opportunity to spend some time in a classroom at Lighthouse School and experience some of the specialist resources.

The facilitators of the workshop are all members of the lighthouse school team and have experience of working with Autistic individuals in a variety of settings.
